

CIRMMT 21st Special *live@CIRMMT* commission

To celebrate CIRMMT's 21st anniversary in the 21st century, we have conceived special *CIRMMT 21st Live@CIRMMT commission* awards to help foster interdisciplinarity and creativity, and to increase student support during the COVID-19 pandemic. The outcome of these special awards is the composition of a new work, to be performed during one of the *live@CIRMMT* concert in celebration of CIRMMT's 21st anniversary.

GOAL

- Composition of an original work, 10-20 minutes in length

FORM

- The work can be either:
 - An Acousmatic work
 - A Mixed work with up to 5 musicians

AWARD

- Number of awards: minimum of 2 awards
- Maximum amount of \$5,000
- Duration: 1 year
- Delivery: the commission should be completed by May 1, 2022; it will be presented during a *live@CIRMMT* concert celebrating CIRMMT's 21st anniversary.

ELIGIBILITY

- New and returning graduate student members, **including** visiting students, are eligible to apply for the *CIRMMT 21st Live@CIRMMT commission*. Post-doctoral members are eligible for this funding.
- **REMINDER:** To be eligible, students must be enrolled during the full period of the award funding. *Students should only apply for one project per application round.*
- **PLEASE NOTE** that to be considered eligible for CIRMMT funding, students are expected to attend:
 - *EITHER* a minimum of 4 out of 6 Distinguished Lectures in the 12 months prior to the application deadline,
 - *OR* a minimum of 3 out of 6 Distinguished Lectures **and** significantly contribute to the organization of a CIRMMT workshop along with the RA co-leaders in the 12 months prior to the application deadline.
 - **NOTE:** In both situations above, **ONE** Distinguished Lecture can be replaced by attending a *live@CIRMMT* concert.
 - Students from universities outside Montreal (U. de Sherbrooke and Université Laval) are exempt, but are encouraged to attend when possible. CIRMMT funding applications will include a section in which students can indicate the Distinguished Lectures they have attended.
 - **Extenuating circumstances will be reviewed - proof must be provided.**

APPLICATION PROCESS

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Quality and originality of the project
- Technical and financial feasibility of the proposal (audio, video, instrumentation, etc.)
- Quality of support material
